Cleaning and care instructions for pillows

SleepAngel® products are ready for immediate use. The product is not sterilized.



1. Intended purpose/technology

SleepAngel® products are hermetically sealed:

- PureShield fabric protection: durable, soft touch, and high-performance textile blocks out contaminants. Vapor permeable and waterproof.
- SafeWeld seams: sealed seams provide complete barrier no stitching holes.
- PneumaPure® filter: Breathable mechanical filter allows clean air flow into the pillow but blocks out pathogens and allergens.

2. Inspection & Cleaning

Before using the product:

- Clean the product (see above)
- Visually inspect the product's seams, cover/fabric and filters for damage or holes. A product with holes or damaged fabric or filter is contaminated and must be disposed of.

Everyday use:

- Visually inspect the product's seams, fabric and filters for damage or holes.
- A product with holes or damaged fabric or filter must be disposed of.
- Clean the pillow at least once a week, after each patient discharge or when soiled.
- Pillows need to be fluffed to maintain the fluffiness of the fibers.
- Ensure that all cleaning and disinfection agents in use comply with manufacturers guidelines.
- Clean with mild detergent and water solution.

- Wait to dry.
- The product is now ready to use

Note:

- Avoid abrasive scrubbing of the filter and fabric.
- Do not bleach, machine wash, dry clean, tumble dry, or iron the product.



The use of alcohol wipes and cleaning solutions can temporarily change the surface of the cover fabric.

3. Audit tool

Remove pillow from removable cover (if present) and check the following:

- Filter is not compromised
- Seams are intact
- Pillow is free from stains
- Pillow is free from visible tears or damage
- Pillow is free from unpleasant odor
- Pillow core is lofted and resilient

If any of the of the above statements is not true, the pillow has failed the audit and must be replaced.

4. Storage and instructions to read LOT

- The pillow can be safely stored flat or on side. Do not bend the pillow, this might damage the PneumaPure[®] filter.
- Do not place weights on the products.
- Store in a dry room at a temperature of +10...+30
 °C.

5. Disposal & Recycling

To dispose of the pillow, cut the pillow open and remove the inner pillow. Dispose of both in medical waste

- PDI Sani-Cloth Bleach Germicidal Disposable Wipe
- Peracedic Acid
