Cleaning Instructions:	Each sling can be laundered up to 80°c using a mild soap solution and then rinse. Slings will air dry quickly in a warm room or in the normal manner. Tumble dry on low setting only. Do not place over a convector heater or steam pipes. Do not use Biological detergents. Do not use Bleach. Do not use strong chemicals. A faded label is an early indicator that sling is subject to harsh / abrasive cleaning methods do not continue to use sling. All slings fitted with a Velcro body belt should have the Velcro square removed during laundering and refitted afterwards. This will significantly extend the lifespan of the product.
